Pinewood Derby Car Race Rules

- Width shall not exceed 2-3/4 inches.
- Length shall not exceed 7 inches.
- Weight shall **not exceed 5 ounces.**
- All 4 wheels must make contact with the track
- Axles, wheels, and body shall be from the materials provided in the kit. Additional BSA approved wheels can be purchased separately.
- Wheel bearings, washers, and bushings are prohibited.
- No lubricating oil may be used. Axles may be lubricated with powdered graphite or silicone.
- The car shall not ride on any kind of spring.
- The car must be free-wheeling, with no starting devices.
- No loose materials of any kind are allowed in the car.
