### **Itinerary**

Friday, 9/11/2026

- Check-In opens at 2pm. Please arrive at your earliest convenience.
- 2pm – 10pm: Arrival/Campsite setup/Dinner/Free time.
- 10 pm: Park quiet time begins.

Saturday, 9/12/2026

- 7am - 10am: Wakeup/Breakfast/Free time.
- 10am – 12pm: Pack 108 Service Project.
  - This service project will consist of walking the disc golf course and collecting trash. Garbage bags will be provided for everyone.
- 12pm – 2pm: Lunch/Free time.
- 2pm – 3pm: Visit from the SCDNR Game Warden at the campsite to talk to the Pack about the purpose of SCDNR and what it means to be a Game Warden.
- 3pm – 5pm: Free time.
- 5pm – 7pm: Dinner/Campfire cooking program.
  - The kids will be making banana boat smores in tin foil packets. All ingredients for this will be provided.
- 7pm – 10pm: Free time.
- 10pm: Park quiet time begins.

Sunday, 9/13/2026

- 7am – 12pm: Breakfast/Pack up campsites
- 12pm: Check Out

## **What to Bring**

Each family will be responsible for bringing their own items required for camping. Below is a basic list of items recommended for this trip. This list is not comprehensive, only a basic recommended list of items. Please bring what your family will need at your discretion.

1. Tent
2. Sleeping Bags (1 per person)
3. Camping Chairs (1 per person)
4. Clothes (Please bring enough for your duration of stay as well as at least 1 extra pair per person as needed)
5. Personal Toiletries
6. First Aid Kit
7. Flashlights (1 per person)
8. Sunscreen/Insect Repellent
9. Extra Pair of shoes per person in the event they get wet
10. Rain Gear (such as a disposable poncho or rain jacket)
11. Pair of gloves for the service project: (Garden gloves or other appropriate hand protection for picking up trash)

## **Food and Water**

Each family will be responsible for their own individual food and water needs. Please bring enough water for at least 1 gallon of water per day per person staying. There are areas at the park to refill water containers as necessary. For those that do not wish to cook on their own, or bring a lot of food, there are multiple restaurants within a 10-minute drive from the park. There is also a Food Lion grocery store within 10 minutes for any last-minute needs. Walmart is located within 15 minutes as well.

## **Restrooms and Showers**

There are immediate restroom facilities located a short distance from the main camping area. These will be available at all hours for use and are separated male and female facilities. Pack 108 will have access on Saturday 9/12/2026 to use the shower facilities located in the camper trailer area of the park. Pack 108 has reserved Camper Lot #19 for parking to use the shower facilities.

## **Weather Forecast**

As of 9/9/2026, the weather forecast for this weekend shows a high of 91 degrees and low of 69 degrees on Friday 9/11/2026 with a 55% chance of rain. Saturday 9/12/2026 shows a high of 83 degrees with a low of 68 degrees and a 55% chance of rain. Sunday 9/13/2026 shows a high of 86 degrees with a low of 68 degrees and a 55% chance of rain.

With the chance of rain forecast, please ensure that you pack accordingly. Extra clothes, shoes, socks, and towels to dry off can make a difference if conditions change. Please plan accordingly to your family's needs.

## **Additional Items to Bring**

Pack 108 will have a campfire each evening weather permitting. We ask each family to bring 1 bundle of firewood with them to this event. Any remaining firewood at the end of the event will either be returned to families as they requested or will be stored in the pack trailer at the church for use at future events. Individual firewood bundles can be purchased and most local grocery stores. They will also be available at the Chester State Park Ranger Station for purchase during normal business hours.

If you have not already turned in your family medical forms, please bring these with you and turn them into Andrew Riddle at the campground.
